Use and ... too, and ... either, and but to show agreement or difference.

AND ... TOO

Use and ... too to show agreement with affirmative sentences.

David likes sports, and Kyle likes sports, too. David likes sports, and Kyle does, too.



## AND ... EITHER

Use and ... either to show agreement with negative sentences.

David doesn't wear glasses, and Kyle doesn't wear glasses either. David doesn't wear glasses, and Kyle doesn't either.

BUT

Use but to show a difference.

Elsa wears glasses, but David doesn't wear glasses. Elsa wears glasses, but David doesn't.
