Use the simple past for actions completed in the past. Add **-ed** to regular verbs. Irregular verbs have different endings.

QUESTIONS

What **did** you **do** last weekend?
she

ANSWERS

I **stayed** home.
She **went** to a party.

QUESTIONS

Did he **stay** home last weekend?
they **go** to a party last weekend?

ANSWERS

Yes, he **did**. No, he **didn't**.
