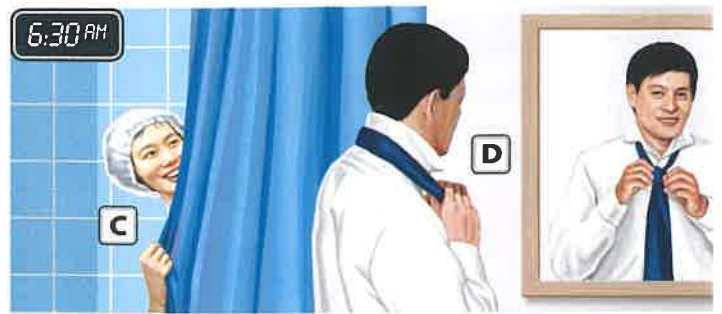




# Daily Routines

N. leave work

### Grammar Point: third-person singular

For *he* and *she*, add *-s* or *-es* to the verb:

*He eats breakfast.*

*He watches TV.*

*She makes lunch.*

*She goes to the store.*

For two-part verbs, put the *-s* on the first part: wakes up, drops off.

*Be* and *have* are different (irregular).

*He is in bed at 5 a.m. He has breakfast at 7 a.m.*
